

Welton Sailing Club

Common Lane, Welton



Welton Sailing Club is based on Welton Waters, a former Clay Pits located on the banks of the Humber estuary. It is about 3 Miles from the Humber Bridge just off the main A63 Hull to Leeds road. Welton Waters is one of the largest sailing lakes in the area, having an area of some 100 acres. It has an "away from it all" feeling and it is an ideal place to learn to sail, or for a leisurely cruise, as well as providing an excellent racing location.

We have a new well-equipped clubhouse that was completed in 1996. There are full changing facilities with hot showers. All facilities are design for disabled access. The Club owns a small fleet of training dinghies, which are available for hire, to those who would like to 'have a go' before deciding to buy their own boat and join the Club. Informal training can be arranged for those new to sailing, and we arrange several training sessions during the season especially for beginners.



The main sailing season runs from April to November, with racing on most Sunday afternoons and Thursday evenings during the summer months. Sailing is possible throughout the winter months although no formal racing program is arranged. Lasers and Streakers are currently the main classes sailed at the club, but we also have Toppers, Larks, Picos, Wayfarers, and Miracles currently sailed at the Club. However, any type of dinghy can be raced,

on a handicap basis. Safety cover is always available when racing or club training sessions are taking place. The Rescue boat is also available to members at other times but without a formal rota to provide a Driver.

A number of social events are organised throughout the year, from BBQ's and Commodore's Day to a formal Dinner or a simple get together in the pub for a meal and chat after an evening's sailing.
