

# WELTON SAILING CLUB 2024 Membership Form & Insurance Indemnity



#### Dear Member,

Due to the weed problems the club has experienced in recent years the board of Welton Water Sports is proposing that club memberships are paid in two parts this year. The first payment, payable now, will cover membership up to the end of June. A further payment will be requested in July to cover membership for the second half of the season. The second payment will only be requested if the pond remains clear enough for a sailing program to be run.

As you will be aware from separate communications the lake has again been treated with blue dye this year so we are hopeful the weed will be kept under control. At present the lake is completely clear for sailing.

The table below gives the total that will be payable if we sail the full season. The Board have again set a discounted membership fee this year due to the disruptions to recent seasons.

On the right-hand side of this page, we present the amounts due for the first and second payments. The membership form overleaf only presents the fee due now, and a further form will be circulated in June if the lake remains clear.

#### <u>Notes</u>

1. Family Membership covers two adults and includes all member's children under 21 on 1<sup>st</sup> January (*Please list all children for whom membership is required – use a separate sheet if necessary*)

2. Junior members must be under 21 on  $1^{st}$  January. Student members must be under 25 years of age and in full time education.

3. County members must reside at least 40 miles away from Welton Waters (as the crow flies). There is no discount on the boat storage & joining / late renewal fees.

4. A discount is offered to all existing members renewing (paying) before the 30<sup>th</sup> April (Discount for renewing early: Family & Single - £15, Junior & Social - £5)

5. Membership is subject to board approval

6. Membership renewal is not effective until this form has been received by the membership secretary and your payment has been confirmed by the treasurer.

7. Members personal data is held and used by various Officers and Directors of the Club, the location and duration of personal data held is specified in Appendix 4 of the Club Rules"

8. All membership fees include use of the free tea & coffee facilities at the club.

# Please read this notice carefully and sign it to indicate your agreement. If you are not able to sign this form, then you must not launch your boat.

Members of the Club, their guests and visitors, use the Club premises and any other facilities of the Club, entirely at their own risk and impliedly accept that;

- The Club will not accept any liability for any damage to, or loss of, any property belonging to members of the Club, their guests and visitors.
- The Club will not accept any liability for personal injury arising out of the use of, the Club premises, the Club Boats, the Club Equipment or any other facility provided by the Club, or out of participation in any race organised by the Club, whether sustained by members, their guests or visitors, whether or not such damage or injury could have been attributed to, or was occasioned by, the neglect, default or negligence of any of the officers, committee or servants of the Club.
- Before inviting any guests or visitors onto the premises, or to participate in events organised by the Club, members must draw their attention to these rules, and to the safety rules of the Club. A copy of the Club's safety policy is available from the Sailing Secretary.
- The race organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage or personal injury, howsoever caused, to the owner/competitor, his skipper or crew, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races.
- Parents and guardians have sole responsibility for the supervision and control of their children and wards at all times.
- I hereby confirm that my boat is insured to its full value and that I have Third Party cover in the sum of £2,000,000

## Safety

The safety of any boat, its fitness to sail and its management ashore and afloat is entirely the responsibility of the persons using it. Regard should be taken of the prevailing conditions and the abilities of all those involved when deciding whether to sail or continue sailing. All craft must provide sufficient buoyancy for all persons on the craft. All persons must in addition wear adequate personal buoyancy when afloat in any craft, on the jetties or near the water edge.

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of those sailing, nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of any person sailing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run events, and include the organising authority, race committees, race officers and those manning rescue craft.

Although the Club will endeavour to provide rescue facilities during Club racing and certain other organised sessions and events, safety on the water is entirely the responsibility of the persons sailing, (or in the case of children, their parent or guardian.) Members should sail only when a competent person is present and when weather conditions are suitable. Irrespective of their level of competence, members are advised not to sail unless at least one other boat is on the water. Recreational swimming is not allowed.
